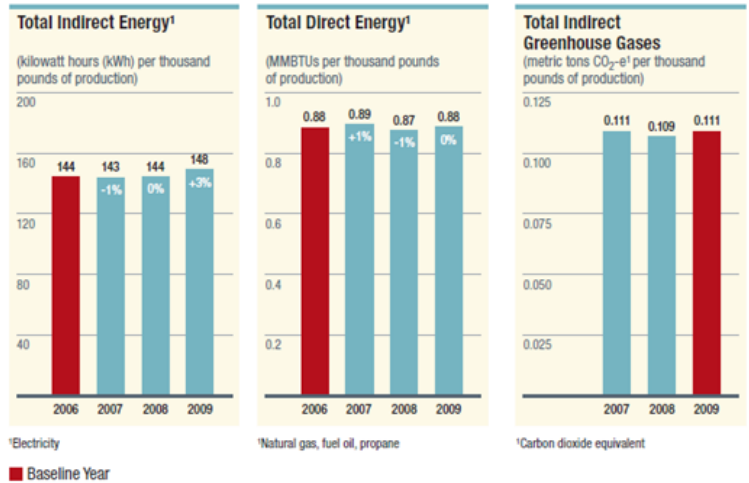

## UNIQUE VALUE TO CUSTOMER

Energy is used in most phases of the Hormel Foods operations for lighting, operating equipment, heating and cooling. To reduce energy use and limit carbon dioxide emissions, Hormel Foods conducts a baseline analysis on one third of our facilities annually. Based on this information, we established benchmarks for 41 facilities to measure energy use and greenhouse gas emissions and plan energy efficient projects to target ways we can conserve and improve energy use.

ADI employees developed and implemented a comprehensive lighting program at 4 facilities throughout the US.

Hormel is on target to save more than \$5 Million over the life of the equipment. (over 20,000,000 kWh of electricity).

At this facility, the confidential investment in lighting technology will save over \$1 million. ADI may work with Hormel Food in the future to make this facility more energy efficient.
